Navy Hill Commission Ordinance

The Commission is created for the purpose of *providing the Council with advice concerning the development contemplated by the Ordinances*. For purposes of section 2-761 of the Code of the City of Richmond (2015), as amended, the Commission is classified as “advisory.”

Advisory. A board or commission is classified as “advisory” if its purpose is to provide advice and comment to the Council, the Mayor or any City agency.
